

Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant must be:
 - an individual member of the LRIW
 - **or** be employed by a corporate member of the LRIW
 - **or** the **dependent** son, daughter, stepchild, grandson or granddaughter of a rail industry employee who is a member of LRIW in good standing or who is employed by a current corporate member.
2. LRIW member applicants must be enrolled as part-time students and have worked for a railroad-affiliated company for at least one year (12 months).
3. Dependent applicants must be enrolled as full-time students (12 hours per semester).
4. All applicants must be currently enrolled at an accredited / post-secondary institution leading to Associates, Bachelors, or Masters Degree. The curriculum must be certified by an accepted accreditation board in the United States.
 - Applicants from Canada or outside the U.S. should be enrolled in a curriculum which has comparable accreditation.
 - The field of study does not have to be transportation or railroad related.
5. The applicant must expect to achieve at least Sophomore Status (30 + credit hours) in his/her institution by the start of the fall 2014 term.
 - High school students are not eligible for this scholarship even with college credit hours.

Amount of Award

A minimum of two scholarships, each in the amount of \$3,000, will be available. The funds will be paid at the beginning of the school term following the applicant's selection and after receiving proof of enrollment. Distribution of funds will be administered by the LRIW Scholarship Coordinator and disbursed to the suitable official of the recipient's institution.

Note: The LRIW Scholarship Committee reserves the right to not distribute funds if there are no suitable scholarship applicants and/or to award all scholarships to dependents if there are no suitable scholarship applicants from members.

A Completed Application Will Consist of

- A. A completed 2014 LRIW Scholarship application form.
- B. A professional resume that contains work experience, education information, community service, involvement in organizations, and any other information the applicant feels appropriate.
- C. A certified college transcript from the school or schools attended which includes college level work completed through December 31, 2013 plus courses in which currently enrolled to verify the applicant's full-time / part-time status. Transcripts printed from a website are not admissible.

D. An essay not exceeding 1,000 words. The essay question is listed below.

Who do you think is the most influential woman in railroading today and why? (could be from railroad, supplier or govt.)

E. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a faculty member at the school in which the applicant is currently enrolled. The other must be from an employee of the Corporate Member of the LRIW other than your related sponsor. These letters must be on school and company letterhead, and should be returned with this application.

Note: Scholarship finalists may be contacted for a telephone interview which could be a factor in determination of the final winner.

Application Process

To apply for the LRIW Scholarship, materials listed below must be sent to the LRIW Scholarship Committee along with the scholarship application. Please mail all items together except for the letter of recommendation and official transcript.

Deadline for Applying for the 2014 School Year

The above material, except item C must be submitted in one envelope and received by Kathy Keeney no later than **July 1, 2014**. The letters of recommendation must also be received separately by July, 1, 2014 in order to have your application considered.

Evaluation and Notification

The Scholarship Committee will base its evaluation for award on the material submitted, and a telephone interview, if required. Scholarship recipients will be notified by Aug. 15, 2014, with distribution of funds to begin no later than the start of the spring 2015.

- Criteria for selection and award of scholarships will be based on the following:
Academic Achievement (40%) / Essay (20%) / Citizenship & Letter of Recommendation (40%)
