

**Director Position:** The Director is responsible for the successful leadership and management of the LRIW according to the strategic direction set by the Board of Directors. Your job is also in strategic planning. Since the Director does not have an official committee assignment, the Director will work with the board to set goals and targets. The Director should work to identify and cultivate other women leaders and work closely with the LRIW committees you sit on. You will be one of four LRIW Directors.

Characteristics & Skills

- Strong leadership, delegation, and communication skills
- Experience with goal setting and strategic planning

Responsibilities:

- With the other Directors, work on setting goals and targets for LRIW. Each year the Directors will be responsible for submitting a proposal of goals and targets for: the current year, the 3-year and 5-year look-a-head to the Board of Directors
- Sit on two board committees; one of which must be the Membership Committee
- Ensure that the committees' operations are aligned with the direction of the LRIW Board
- Ensure that the LRIW's operations meet the expectations of its members and sponsors
