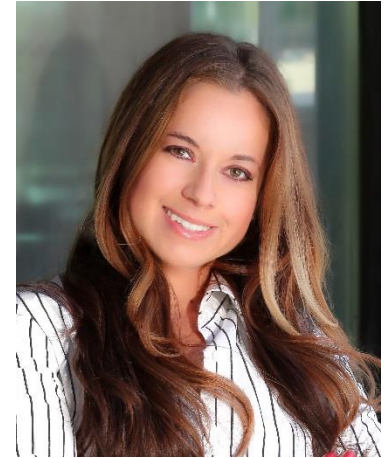


Kari Gonzales
