Emilia Marceta started her railway career in 2007, in the Strategic Communications department at GO Transit. A division of Metrolinx, GO Transit, or GO, is a regional public transit service for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton area that carries over 65 million passengers annually by rail and bus.

As a communications coordinator, Emilia worked on creating and executing many communications strategies for commuter improvement programs and initiatives. She then went on to join the Infrastructure Communications group where she was the communications program manager for all expansion project environmental assessments. In 2011, she joined the Capital Infrastructure group, under the Track & Signals team. In this role, she was the lead contract administrator for a multi-year, multi-million dollar contract for the provision of main and non-main track protection within Metrolinx rights-of-way. This opportunity afforded her a great deal of exposure to railway construction, operations, and regulatory practices. In 2017, following a capital program restructuring, she began working in the Network Infrastructure group on the Signals & Communications team as a project coordinator. Her primary responsibilities include financial control and contract administration for the enhanced train control program.
